But there is one more reason why I'm going to watch video courses and write reviews. It's of course my own improvement. Because I'm sure that if a video course is really good I'll learn something new and improve my English as well.

It's my decision and I'm going to keep it up. As a man with a good level of English I can say if a course is good or not. After almost two years of learning I acquire good knowledge about learning process. Now I understand what's really important when we learn English and what common mistakes can people make.

For now I plan to write reviews about following video courses:

- 1. Learning English by 25th cadre. (Yes yes I know that it's all untrue and the 25th cadre doesn't exist. But anyway I'm going to make sure and see what the authors offer!)
- 2. Learning English by Drogunkin's method.
- 3. English on the sofa by Dina Kopceva.

My opinion about video courses of learning English.

My friends I'd like to ask you a question — do you think it's possible to learn how to drive a car by a video course? You can answer «If I really want it then yes it's possible». Now I want you to think exactly so about video courses about learning English! It's true that if you watch a really good video course and combine it with practise, you'll learn to drive a car.

The same thing with English, if you want to learn English a good video course will help you. Notice that I said «help». It can't teach you speak English without any activities from yourself. But it might be a good helper for you in the beginning.

To tell you the truth I'm thinking of making my own video courses where I could share with people my experience and give good pieces of advice to help them in learning. But so far it's just ideas. Will see.

The second important point is the prise of video courses. Just think about how much it costs to have a tutor nowadays. For only one lesson you'll have to pay about 30\$. And it doesn't mean that your tutor will be good one. But it's very important. Or prises of the common classes? It's about 1000\$ for one term.

And now let's see how much video courses cost. At average it's about 100-200\$ for one course. And you have to pay just once. Is it a lot? I don't think so.

In conclusion I'd like to say that a really good video course made first of all for people but not for money can help you a lot. But you should understand absolutely clearly that everything depends on you only! Try to look at video courses clearly. Don't believe that it's possible to start speak English in two weeks or one month. It's impossible my friends. I know what I'm saying because I got through it.

If you really want to learn English as quickly as possible you can do it! But you should work hard in this case. And good video course will always help you on this way. Keep that in mind.
