Hi my friends and welcome back to my blog! In this article I'll tell you about Conditional mood and subjunctive of English. They're very important rules to know. They make your speech much easier and help you to feel more confident in a conversation! Here we go!

We use Conditional Mood to represent an action that would happen under certain conditions expressed or implied. For example:

I would go there, but I don't know where it is.

I would never say it to her.

I would read this book, but I can't find it.

We would go for a walk.

But for the rain we would play football.

The subjunctive is used to represent an action as contrary to reality. Also we use subjunctive in adverbial clauses of condition when the realization of the condition is impossible or unlikely. For example:

If I were you I would call her.

If I had gone to the party I would have missed the game.

If you were more sensible, you would not have done it.

If only I could go with you.

If only it could always be the summer.

I wish I could stay.

I wish I knew about it.

I wish you had come to me.
