Вводные слова в английском

Hello, my friends! In this article I'd like to tell you about popular words which are used in the conversation. They make your English much easier and it's very convenient to use them in different situations.

In English there are lots of words like that, but I'd like to pay attention to the most widely used of them.

1. Anyway.

I've already told you about this word in the article «Using of Anyway in English». This is the most popular word in the English language. You can hear it a lot from native speakers. And it's not a surprise, cause you can use it almost everywhere you want.

«Anyway» is translated as «тем не менее, так или иначе, в любом случае и т.п.» For example:

I don't want to go there. But, anyway, I'll go with you.

(Я не хочу идти туда. Но, все равно, я пойду с тобой)

Anyway, it's not easy way out, but we have to do it.

(Так или иначе, это не лучший выход, но мы должны это сделать)

Anyway, I'll help you!

(В любом случае, я тебе помогу)

English it's not so easy. Anyway, I like learning it.

(Английский-это непросто. Но, так или иначе, мне нравится его учить)

2. Honestly.

A good word in spoken English. It's the short form of the phrase «to tell you the truth». I like using this word in the conversation. It's easy and sounds very nice. For example:

Honestly, I didn't like that movie.

(Честно говоря, мне не понравилось то кино)

Honestly, I liked the way you said that.

(Если честно, мне понравилось, как ты это сказал)

Honestly, I didn't have time to do these exercises.

(Если честно, у меня не было времени, чтобы сделать эти упражнения)

3. Actually.

A cool word which you can use in different situation. It's translated as «вообще-то». Let's get to examples:

Actually, I didn't say it.
(Вообще-то, я этого не говорил)
Actually, I've sung this song the first.
(Вообще-то, я спел эту песню первый)
I don't actually know what to say about it.
(Я вообще-то и не знаю, что сказать об этом)
4. Probably.
One more good word for the conversational English. The translation is «вероятно»:
Probably, I was wrong.
(Вероятно, я ошибался)
Probably, we'll go together to the party.
(Вероятно, на вечеринку мы пойдем вместе)
Probably, you'll be late for the train.
(Вероятно, мы опоздаем на поезд)
5. Obviously.
This word means «очевидно, безусловно». For example:
Obviously, they're the best friends.
(Очевидно, они лучшие друзья)
Obviously, it's the most difficult part of our journey.
(Безусловно, это самая сложная часть нашего путешествия)
Obviously, he's lying.
(Очевидно, он лжет)
There is one more similar word — «apparently».
6. Practically.
It's not so often, but very useful word too. It means «практически, в сущности, на деле»:
It's practically impossible.
(Это практически невозможно)
```

It's practically the same.

(Это практически тоже самое)
