Употребление глагола take

Hi everyone! Today's article is dedicated to the verb «take». It's a very important word for a conversation. I'll tell you about how to use it properly in different situations. Here we go!

1) «Take» in the meaning of getting something. For example:

I'll take this book tomorrow.

May I take a stick of chocolate?

I didn't take your jacket!

Also if you're talking about people you can use «take» as well:

I'll take you with me.

Take me away from here please!

May I take my sister to the movies?

2) «Take» in the meaning of giving a lift.

Can you take me home?

Can you take us to the Railway Station?

Can you take me to the Madison Street?

There are many phrasal verbs with the word «take». I'll tell you about three the most popular ones.

• take off smth – to undress.

Take off your shoes please.

By the way you can say «Take your shoes off please». Both variants are right.

• take care of smb/smth – to care for smb/smth.

Could you take care of my dog please?

Take care of your little brother.

Take care!

• take up - to start doing something that you're interested in.

I've taken up dancing!

I took up tennis one year ago.

Also you can use this phrasal verb if something fills an amount of time or space. For example:

Painting takes up the most of my life.

This table takes up too much room.
