О принятии решения на английском

Good afternoon all my dear subscribers and guests of my blog! This post is going to be about good expressions which will help you to speak of your decisions. There are several useful phrases in English that will expand your vocabulary and will make you feel more confident in the conversation. Here we go!

Begin with, in English the verb «pematb» is translated as «to decide». And notice that we use this word only if we're talking about our ideas and decisions. If you want to say that you worked out a problem there is another verb — «to solve». So you can say «I solved the problem». Also this verb is used if we're talking about calculations, for example:

I solved this exercise.

But in this article we're talking about our decisions. In English you can say:

I decided to help you.

We decide to go to the cinema.

Another good set expression is «to make a decision»:

He made a decision to go abroad.

She made a decision to move to another town.

There is one more good phrase I like a lot - «to make up smb's mind»:

I made up my mind to start learning English.

They made up their mind to go shopping.

The next phrase is «to come to a decision»:

I came to a decision to write a book.

She came to a decision to enter the university.

And the last phrase I'm going to tell you about is «to come up with an idea». For example:

I came up with an idea to do sports, because it's very good for my health.

He came up with an idea to travel around the World.

She came up with an idea to become an interpreter, because it's a well-paid job nowadays.

That's it my friends. Try to use these phrases in the conversation.
